The Pharmaceutical College, Barpali was established in the year 1986-87 in Diploma with 40 intake capacity. At the beginning the College witnessed many huddles but by the blessing of some Supreme Power the problems were smoothly over. Subsequently, the PCI Inspector inspected and recommended for 60 intake capacity in Diploma. This College has never compromised regarding quality teaching as a result our student have shown their merit in the State Level by placing them selves in the Best Ten List. This College has once received Governor Medal as a token of outstanding Institution. It is seen in the rural area the village quacks are moving one corner to other corner in state with having no knowledge in medicine as a result the life of the rural belt people are in danger. Further, their is serious unemployment problem and qualified youth are moving without a job to maintain their livelihood and the Govt. is not in a position to give them employment. The pharmaceutical Colleges in Orissa have solved the problem of unemployment by self employment. This has solved the problem of youth, government and rural people in all respect. Although in some Colleges the authority are not maintaining quality teaching and not providing lab for knowledge of student. This College is upgraded in the year of 1999-2000 and affiliated to Sambalpur University. The students of degree course has shown their merits in the University level. This College is managed by a managing committee who are competent in all sphere. The M.C is changed time and again as per the provision of the by-law. The Committee is managed by Sri. Narendra Hota, President of M.C who is always keen for the development of students, staff & the Institution. Beside there is a Governing Body as per AICTE norms which is managed by renowned social worker Sj. Rajib Lochan Hota, Ex.MLA who is now the Chairman of Governing Body and founder of the same institution. At present the library, computer and laboratory are well sophisticated This College has completed its 20 years with many ups & down. Recently this institution has get the approval from AICTE to open M.Pharm and the admission for the first batch has already been completed. There are a group of experience faculty members with

sense of responsibility and good quality teaching. After the Degree College this is shifted to Tingipali area in 5.52 acres of own land, which was purchased a long back. After shifting the College, this College is dedicated to Maa Samaleswari to take care of the College in all respect. The College has so far constructed 50000 sq. ft of plinth area and further construction is also in progress.

Since the College is established in western Orissa which is a most neglected part of Orissa. We are facing problem at the time of admission. Further, it is never desirable on the part of government to place the pharmacy wings under BPUT. The medical Colleges are under the regional university and it is not understood why the Pharmacy College which is part of medical group is shifted to BPUT. BPUT which is mainly taking care of engineering stream and the pharmacy wing is always neglected. It is suggested that the government of Orissa may be considered this to place the pharmacy wings under the control of regional University and when there will be a chance to run a medical University in the State. All the medical and Pharmacy Colleges may be put in the same University for better administration. The counseling of students for admission must be on regional basis to facilitate the students of the neglected area to take admission in their choicest College.
